- **FFF Meeting:** **Adriana** informs about an on-going dispute between the FFF Board and the chair of Gothenburg Physics Center regarding whether the board should get credit for their work in the form of departmental hours. At the moment, there exists no official document saying whether FFF should get paid or not. Negotiations will take place on Friday (18/2). FFF and the local councils have agreed on the following solution for the future of FFF. The FFF chair and treasurer should be elected separately and have departmental hours for their work. The other members of the board should consist of representatives from the different Physics PhD councils. In this way, it is assured that all get paid for their work.
- **Intranet Dialogue:** The administrative personell of the Chalmers Intranet get a lot of e-mails from PhD students who do not know how to navigate on Chalmers Intranet. Therefore, the administrators want to inform the CPPC board about the different features of the Intranet platform.
