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1 Opening

The meeting was opened by Sara. Adriana was made secretary.

2 Agenda

3 Follow up on previous meetings

- We will further discuss the best practices of the corona situation on another meeting.
- The workshop, organized by the DS, Navigate Academia, Maximize your potential is now taking place with about 60 students.
- Sara asked Lena about the *Introduction day* and we discussed later the details.
- Adriana will contact Daniel for giving a short presentation about the gender course during the next meeting.

• Regarding teaching hours, Anna checks what is written in the ISP and extends the contract accordingly. Thomas Nilsson has agreed on 2% for members of the CPPC (4% for the chair), we should check if we have any official document backing this up. Sara did not find information in the statues, so she will ask either Thomas or Lena.

4 Introduction day

- He is currently working on a document to explain the way we are compensated for the teaching hours with GU physics. It will be shared with us once it is finished.
- He sends the teaching hours information directly to Anna and the directors of studies, and we asked to be involved in such conversation.
- He will look into how the lab hours are compensated to include the hours spent in grading reports.
- We should encourage people to keep track of their own hours and to ask for the necessary compensation.

6 Annual assembly

- The agenda should be sent out at least 2 weeks in advance and we will decide it in further meetings.
- We should decide who will be the new auditor. Our current auditors are Adam Ardvinsson and Mikkel. None of them are at Chalmers anymore, maybe they can send us a statement after reading them.

• Mathew Sadd and Alvaro Posada are the current nominating committee. Sara will ask how many we can be to have an idea of how many people they should nominate. The statutes say that we should be at least 3 people. Nitesh and Sara will not continue, so at least there should be one more person.
