Lena Falk, along with the rest of the writing group (Anna Lindqvist, Jan Svensson and Christophe Demaziere) wants input from CPPC at the first meeting with the writing group on the 1st of February. Due to limited time during the CPPC board meeting, it was decided to construct a form in Teams were relevant points and questions could be gathered. The potential of constructing a survey to send to Physics PhD-students was discussed, and will likely be suggested during the meeting on February 1st.

6 Updates from other meetings

(i) Equality Council

The Equality Council had a meeting in November and in addition to that, there was a joint meeting with the other equality councils within Gothenburg Physics Center (GPC). The idea with the joint effort is to start more active collaborations in between the departments, in the form of working groups. The next joint meeting will take place on the 23rd of January, and the formation of three working groups will be discussed during the meeting:

- Student outreach
- Cultural survey
- Baseline education for employees in managing positions regarding equality, diversity and inclusion

Regarding the Action plan connected to the results from the **Gender-based violence** in higher education survey, no actual actions has been carried out, however, an event is being planned with Maria Saline on this topic, which would be open to PhD students. The board should think about how attendance could be ensured. One way could be to have division heads promote it, and another to choose an appropriate time for the meeting, during lunch being one potential option.
