5. Information on MC2 PhD student council activities the past year

This year the MC2 PhD student council activities have been largely focused on finding strategic issues to monitor and work with, and overall our role within MC2 and Chalmers at large. This includes topics such as immigration issues, gender equality and the relation between PhD students, supervisors and examiners.

In most cases, there exists instances for the students to turn to, such as ISMO (International Staff Mobility Office) or DOMB (Doktorandombudet), and so we aim at working primarily with strategic,

systematic issues. That said, it is not always obvious exactly where to turn to, and we do encourage students to turn to us with issues and grievances, even if only for a referral to the most suitable instance.

In addition, during the year we have set up a system to anonymously track issues, in order to find systematic problems that may not be obvious otherwise. If you have a specific issue today, we may not be able to do much, but if over two years, ten PhD students have the exact same issue, there may be an underlying problem which we can improve.

This year, and continuing into 2020, the doctoral student guild (DS) has started a project to increase the collaboration between the local PhD councils all over Chalmers as well as with DS itself. This is useful to find out what parts of the PhD education in MC2 is unique to MC2 and which are the same all over Chalmers. There may be things we can learn from other departments. Also, the MC2 PhD Council will act as representatives from MC2 within projects running centrally, such as the ongoing project to create electronic versions of the individual study plans.

Finally, it is our goal that every PhD student in MC2 should be aware of the MC2 council, and be familiar with the local representative at each division. For this we have started to give out welcome letters and personal introductions to new PhD students, and council members should introduce themselves at lab meetings every year.
